

Project Engineer

You are responsible for working in and managing various projects. These include both internal projects in the field of equipment and installations and customer projects. In addition, you are involved in carrying out qualification and process validation projects of existing equipment and new products/processes to be developed.

Your tasks and responsibilities:

- Efficiently carrying out technical projects regarding equipment, installations and/or cleanrooms (including drawing up URS, qualification documents and providing training).
- Carrying out and checking FAT/SAT and DQ/IQ/OQ/PQ processes (qualifying equipment).
- Defining maintenance plans along with the Equipment Engineer.
- Performing process validations in order to meet relevant requirements. Defining process validation programs and validation documents for new and existing products/processes.
- Assessing the need for revalidation of processes based on FMEAs, SPC and process evaluations.
- Project management for customer and internal technical projects; drawing up a project plan, project planning, progress documents and monitoring and managing progress. Regular contact with customers, supplier and any other external companies.

- HBO/Bachelor relevant educational background in a technical field. F.e. process engineer or (Bio)Chemical Technology) but also f.e. mechanical engineering or marine engineering, with an affinity for process technology.
- At least 3 to 5 years of relevant work experience, with broad technical knowledge and experience. Experience in a production environment of medical devices or pharmaceuticals is an advantage.
- Experience in equipment qualification and process validation, Project Management.
- Hands-on mentality, self-starter and results-oriented, reporting skills.
- Good knowledge of Dutch and English language (spoken and written).
